



## ***Medicaid Document Checklist***

In order to apply for Medicaid you need to have proof of identity, social security, marital status, income, resources, rent/mortgage, and New York state residency. Examples of these are as follows:

### **Identity: (One of the following)**

- Birth Certificate
- Passport
- Driver's License
- Non Driver's ID
- Nationalization papers
- Green card

### **Proof of Social Security:**

- Social Security card

### **Proof of Insurance:**

- Medicare card
- Any third party insurance card with invoice and proof of payment (if applicant is paying for it)

### **Marital Status:**

- Marriage certificate
- Divorce decree
- Death certificate
- Clergy letter

### **Income: (Whatever applies)**

- Social Security award letter
- Pension statement
- Pay stubs
- Bank interest statements
- IRA distribution statements

### **Resources: (Whatever applies)**

- Checking account
- IRA
- CD
- Savings account
- Life insurance policy
- Stock holds

### **Rent/Mortgage: (One of the following)**

- Rent receipt
- Lease
- Mortgage statement

### **New York State Residency: (One of the following)**

- Rent receipt
- Lease
- Deed
- Utility bill
- Letter from landlord
